Respected audience! I would like to express my deep gratitude for giving me an opportunity to preside over this august gathering. I request you all to pray for me.

The need of organizing Anti terrorism conference

Respected audience! Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind is a historical organization which has since its inception strived for peaceful coexistence, national cohesion and world peace. It has always protested against tyranny of its own people and others alike and come forward in defense of oppressed and downtrodden sections of society irrespective of caste, creed, race and religion. During the pre and post independence era, it never encouraged destructive and provocative elements of society. But it always encouraged constructive elements and guided the community and the nation to lead a life of dignity. It has earned laurels from both friends and foe for its valuable contribution to the nation building.

After the disintegration of Soviet Union, a new word “Islamic Terrorism” has been coined and propagated widely to tarnish the image of Islam which is a religion of peace and brotherhood. After the tragic incident of 9/11, Islam and Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) have come under severe attack from its detractors and have been labeled as a fountainhead of violence and terrorism. Whenever and wherever terrorists strike Islam and Muslims are held responsible for it. It is a blatant attempt to malign Muslims and Islam. Late Maulana Asad Madani, ex-president of Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind had been very anxious over these developments. He strove hard to defend Muslims and Islam. For this purpose, he published Islamic literature in different languages replete with humanism and even held a “community cohesion” conference in London. The excerpt of his presidential address is mentioned hereunder. He said: *In the modern world attempts are being made to disfigure Islam and perhaps it poses biggest challenge to its followers. The enemies of Islam are busy doing their worst to malign Islam. It is painful that we are helping them. The*

accusation of practical involvement could be limited to certain individuals or groups but as far as our complicity as a silent spectator is concerned; I think that none of the members of the Muslim community can be condoned for the guilt. Therefore, it is our biggest duty to save Islam from disfigurement. For this we have to take two actions –

Firstly, the media is being used to spread misunderstanding and falsehood about Islam. Due to this wall of hatred and prejudices between Muslims and their brothers is being erected. We should use the same media to remove those misunderstandings. Without this the duty of Dawat and Tableegh cannot be performed.

Secondly in our practical lives we should initiate the process of repairing and reforming our inter-community relations with a view to bridge the gulf and replace the hatred with love. This is the real teaching of Islam and its true spirit.

Attempts have been made to malign Islam by attributing it with baseless allegations. By linking terrorism with Islam, its real message has been swept under carpet, So that it could not blaze the world. Hate campaign against Muslims is on in entire world particularly in India to wipe them out from this land like Jews were annihilated in Germany. Devout Muslims who are votaries of human rights, equality, women's rights and freedom have been branded as dreaded terrorists. In this scenario is it not our duty to tell the international community that UN charter dealing with right to freedom and human rights are derived from Islamic principles? Have a glance at UN charter and then think about the holy Quran and Prophet's traditions.

Article 1 - All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood.

Article 4 - No one shall be held in slavery or servitude; slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.

Article 18 - Everyone has the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion; this right includes freedom to change his religion or belief, and freedom, either alone or in community with others and in public or private, to manifest his religion or belief in teaching, practice, worship and observance.

Article 25. (1) Everyone has the right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of himself and of his family, including food, clothing, housing and medical care and necessary social services, and the right to security in the event of unemployment, sickness, disability, widowhood, old age or other lack of livelihood in circumstances beyond his control.

(2) Motherhood and childhood are entitled to special care and assistance. All children, whether born in or out of wedlock, shall enjoy the same social protection.

Article 26. (1) Everyone has the right to education. Education shall be free, at least in the elementary and fundamental stages. Elementary education shall be compulsory. Technical and professional education shall be made generally available and higher education shall be equally accessible to all on the basis of merit.

(2) Education shall be directed to the full development of the human personality and to the strengthening of respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms. It shall promote understanding, tolerance and friendship among all nations, racial or religious groups, and shall further the activities of the United Nations for the maintenance of peace.

(3) Parents have a prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be given to their children.

Article 27. (1) Everyone has the right freely to participate in the cultural life of the community, to enjoy the arts and to share in scientific advancement and its benefits.

(2) Everyone has the right to the protection of the moral and material interests resulting from any scientific, literary or artistic production of which he is the author.

The above provisions of human rights and liberty introduced in the 20th century were laid down and enforced by Islam 14 centuries ago and Prophet Mohammad (PBUH) and his rightful Caliphs used these provisions in their times to present a practical model of peaceful and coherent polity. (Khutbate-Fida-e-Millat- pp. 587-589)

Hazrat Fida-e-Millat was opposed to many movements in the world that did not conform to basic principles of Islam. He was also opposed to linking Islam with the wrongs committed by a handful

of individuals. But despite making best efforts, the European countries especially America stepped up its aggression against Muslims and Islam. In India too despite the fact that government agencies have record of listed terrorist organizations, they blame Muslims after every incident of terrorism. Media too is involved in maligning Muslims and Islam by highlighting baseless stories of Muslim's involvement in terrorists' attack.

Darul Uloom Deoband had organized Anti Terrorism conference on February 25, 2005. Its messages of peace and brotherhood reverberated throughout the world and got wide appreciation. Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind has decided to take forward message of this conference to every nook and corner of the world.

Islam and world peace

Respected Islamic Scholars! Islamic teachings are replete with reference to international peace and human brotherhood. In many Ahadith (prophet's traditions). Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) issued special instructions to be kind to the all creations of Allah Almighty. In one of the Hadith Prophet Mohammad is reported to have said, Allah is kind to those who are kind to his creations, if one is kind to Allah's creations on the earth, Allah Almighty who is sitting on throne in Heaven will be kind to him. (Mishkat Shariff: 523/2)

In one Hadith Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) is reported to have said, those who are not kind to his creations, Allah is also not kind to him. (Mishkat Shariff: 421/2)

Respect of Human Life in Islam

Unjust killing of men is heinous crime in Islam. It describes killing an innocent person as equivalent to killing whole mankind (Sura Almaidah)

Every drop of human blood is precious in Islam; therefore protection of human life gets top priority in an Islamic state. Thus in an Islamic state, killing of Muslims or Non-Muslims is strictly prohibited. Allah says in the holy Quran: Nor take life-which Allah has made sacred—except For just cause. And if anyone is slain wrongfully, we have given his heir option (to either demand compensation for the loss of life or to forgive); but let him not exceed bounds in the matter of taking life; for he is helped (by the law) (Surat Bani Israil: V.33)

Unjust killing attracts severe punishment in an Islamic state. There is provision of life for life for unjust killing or paying heavy compensation to the heir of the slain. Such strict law is framed to prevent further unjust killing by the criminals and anti-social elements.

Western Laws

Contrary to strict penal code of Islam the flexible and flawed legal system of Western countries encourages killing of innocent in every part of the world. It acts as shield for culprits. Therefore whole world is littered with the blood of innocent persons.

Behavior of Muslims with non-Muslims

Dear audience! The enemy of Islam has fabricated vicious propaganda that Islam is hostile to non-Muslims. But this allegation stands on weak wicket. The truth is that according to Islam non-Muslims all over the world are of two categories;

(1) Hostile non-Muslims, who prevent Muslims from professing and practicing religious belief and commit atrocity upon them. It is strictly prohibited in Islam to have friendly interaction with such Non-Muslims, because friendly interaction with them is likely to cause harm to Muslims and Islam.

(2) The non-Muslims who are at peace with Muslims. They neither interfere in the religious beliefs and practices of Muslims nor do they pose any threat to their survival. Islam encourages Muslims to maintain cordial relations and stresses to be at best behavior with such kind of non-Muslims. Allah Almighty in the holy Quran has made sharp distinction between these two categories of non-Muslims. Allah says in the Holy Quran:

Allah forbids not, with regard to those who Fight you not for (your) faith nor drive you out of your homes, From dealing kindly and justly with them: For Allah loveth those who are Just. Allah only forbids you, with regard to those who fight you for (your) Faith, and drive you out of your homes, and support (Others) in driving you out, from turning to them (For friendship and protection). It is such as turn to them (In these circumstances), That do wrong. (Al-Mumtahana: V. 8-9)

Thus the Quranic verses about the killing of non-Muslims could

not be viewed as categorical remark against all non-Muslims. These Quranic verses exhort and order Muslims to kill only those infidels who are fighting with them. Thus indiscriminate and unjust killing of all non-Muslims has no sanction of the Holy Quran.

In an Islamic state the non-Muslims have right to life and property like Muslims. Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) has strictly condemned harassing non-Muslim in an Islamic state. He said: The killer of a dhimmi (non Muslim citizen of an Islamic state) will never smell even a little fragrance of paradise. Though the fragrance of paradise can be smelt from a distance of forty years of pedestrian walk. (Rawah-ul Bukhari: Mishkat 299)

Respect of human life in Islam during wartime

Respected Audience: In Islam human rights are precious even during wartime. Islam has laid down strict guidelines for safety and protection of non-combatants and innocents. It calls upon its adherents to fulfill agreement made with the enemies. It is a historical record that Muslims have sincerely implemented every clause of regional or international agreements. Contrary to it, the enemies of Islam have always committed breach of dealings with Muslims. Since Islam is a religion of fairness and broad-mindedness, therefore the army of Islamic state has always shown forbearance and tolerance with the conquered.

Living example of Islamic liberalism and tolerance is reflected from generosity of Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) to enemies on the occasion of victory of Mecca. On this occasion, Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) had granted general amnesty to all his enemies.

Abu Sufyan, was in the forefront in many battles against Muslims, but converted to Islam on the occasion of victory of Mecca. He received consolation from Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) in the following words, "Those are at peace who entered the house of Abu Sufyan." Abu Sufyan has been reported to have said, "How many people can find accommodation in my house? Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) replied, "Those also will be at peace who have entered into the Holy Kaaba." Abu Sufyan said, "how many persons can find shelter in the Holy Kaaba? Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) replied, "Those also are at peace

who entered into Masjid-e-Haram. But all these replies of Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) were not sufficient for Abu Sufyan and he went on complaining. Thereupon Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) made final declaration and said that every one will be at peace that closes his door and sits inside his home. Abu Sufyan heaved a sigh of relief upon that last declaration of Prophet Mohammad (pbuh). (Albadaya wal Nihaya: 684/4)

Prohibition of killing women and children during war

Islam teaches that no one should be overtaken by the madness during the war as to target indiscriminately whoever comes forward. Even in the state of war it is necessary to keep an eye upon who is on the forefront. Those who are neutral, infirm, innocent such as women, old, children, ascetic and priest must be spared. It is a serious crime to kill them. Hzt. Abdullah Bin Omar^(RA) says that in one of the Holy battle the Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) chanced upon the dead body of woman who had been killed, he issued orders not to kill women and children. (Muslim Sharif 84/6, Musannaf Ibne Shaiba 486/6)

As per the tradition, the first caliph, while seeing off his army to a certain mission of war issued ten instructions to its commander: (1) Don't kill any child (2) Don't raise your hands against any woman. (3) Don't slay any old person. (4) Don't cut any fruit bearing-tree. (5) Don't slaughter any goat and camel needlessly. (6) Don't burn any orchard. (7) Don't destroy any garden by flooding it with water. (8) Don't be coward. (10) Don't misappropriate the booty acquired in war.

Hadrat Abdullah Ibne Abbas (RA) says that the prophet while dispatching his troops cautioned them.

In a Hadith Prophet Mohammad is reported to have said, "do not kill a monk who is engrossed in prayers in a monastery".

The above traditions of Prophet Mohammad (pbuh) make it clear that Islam is opposed to killings and oppression of innocents. The Islamic teachings stress respect for life.

Double standard

Respected audience! Eradication of oppression and injustice from the world will ensure peace and tranquility in the world. Peace can

only be restored in the world if we take impartial stand against all oppressors irrespective of religious considerations. If we want to eradicate the menace of terrorism, we must end oppression, injustice and deprivation from the world.

Recommendation of Sachar Committee Report

The implementation of Sachar Committee Report will help eradication of injustice and deprivation. Therefore, the Government of India should take immediate action for its implementation.

Dual policy of America

Although, America regarded itself as a votary of peace, but its action in many parts of the world created social unrest and chaos as it adopts dual policy in many matters wherever its interests are involved.

It is a well-known fact that America has been acting as a moral police in the world. But on many international affairs it has acted contrary to that. It has adopted a dual policy on many issues of international peace. Whenever Christian and American interests are hurt in any part of the world, they take prompt action to set the things right at the cost of huge losses of human lives. On the contrary wherever and whenever Muslims become victims, they maintain studied silence and side with the oppressors.

In the decade of 1990, all sorts of atrocities were perpetrated against Bosnian Muslims. Thousands of Muslims men, women and children were butchered in broad daylight in the newly independent Muslim country. But America and the UN did nothing to stop ethnic cleansing. On the contrary, they sided with the Serbians and they intervened only when the Muslims had lost everything. Same story is being repeated in Chechnya and Kosovo, but they are doing nothing but lip service to defend them.

Illegitimate support to Israel

For the last sixty years, America has been supporting its illegitimate child i.e., Israel which has been perpetrating all sorts of atrocities upon innocent Palestinians. Time and again peace processes in West Asia have been conducted just to give a false hopes to

Palestinians. America has provided all sorts of moral and material support to Israel, which has perpetrated all sorts of heinous crime against Palestinians. The issue of Palestine, is not only a challenge to Arab countries but also to every Muslim of the world. After 9/11, perpetration of atrocity upon Iraqi and Afghan Muslims by America has brought shame to the entire world. To an extent, same scenario does prevail in our own country. Those who committed atrocity and terrorism upon innocent people enjoy patronage of the Government. Though charges of offense have been proved against them but still they are free. The Government has completely failed to do justice to the victims.

Clever Tactics of Rumor-Mongering Against Muslims

Respected audience! I would like to recount some stories that will reveal how those forces, which create fear of terrorism among common masses, have been hand in gloves with terrorists. Some interesting stories are mentioned below:

(1) On October 18, 2003 a news story was flashed by the media that in 1998-1999 anti-terrorism operations were launched with the active collaboration of FBT, an Israeli intelligence agency. This operation was launched exactly at a time when Mr. Bill Clinton was acting as a mediator for bringing peace between Israel and Palestine. Mr. Jeneet Refew acting Attorney General of the USA at that time accepted this fact. For the first time, FBT accepted its role in that conspiracy but never approached the court. For conducting that operation, FBT funded thousands of dollars to the leaders of Hamas to buy arms and ammunitions and indulge in all sorts of violent activities so that the peace process started by Mr. Bill Clinton could not succeed. Mr. Harry Alien, a businessman from Arizona testified in the court that Mr. Kenneth Weliams, an operative of the FBT said that these dollars should be handed over to an activist of Hamas. Mr. Barjar, a senior advisor of Mr. Bill Clinton said that white house was kept in dark about these activities. This information has been obtained from the court proceedings and testimonies of the witnesses. On October 18, 2002 this information was released by the press agencies from Washington.

On one hand America and western countries regard Hamas as

a terrorist organization, on the other hand they secretly fund it to carry out violence. Is this not terrorism?

(2) On January 24, 2006 news was released from Washington that “America has funded 20 lakh dollars to Al-Fatah, a terrorist organization. The New York Times reported that Makala Sweter Belham, an employee of the American business consulate said that this entire money shall be spent to defeat Hamas. In another story The New York Times reported that (U.S.A.I.D) spent 20 lakh dollars in Palestine for welfare project (Shah Times, December 24, 2006)

All the news stories point to a bigger game plan of America in Muslim countries. But nobody seems ready to say that these activities are nothing but terrorism. The UN and its Security Council do not take notice of such news stories. But if any other country extends the same kind of financial assistance to an organization then it creates ripples across many countries.

(3) On November, 23,2006, Mr. Alexander Latvinekov, a former colonel of K.G.B was murdered in London by using plutonium 210. Before his death he had penned a book in which he had revealed his black deeds. He had written in the book that K.G.B had planned and executed bomb blasts in Moscow in 1999 that resulted in the death of 800 persons and also orchestrated hostage drama in Moscow theater in 2002. These incidents were planned to incite hatred against Muslims and provide justification for military action against Chechniya (Rashtariya Sahara, December 14, 2006).

A former operative of the K.G.B has to pay for his life for revealing the bitter truth. But the entire world remained silent over this overt action of terrorism and even justified the killing of colonel by forging absurd theories.

(4) There is a web site named Scholars for 9/11 truth. This website operates under the supervision of 70 prominent scientists and scholars. These scholars supported the White House for launching attacks on Iraq and Afghanistan for controlling the oil rich counties of West Asia. This group contended that the twin towers can not collapse if an aircraft. The fuel of the plane can not generate the amount of heat which may cause the collapse of that building. Bombs were used

in the basement of the building to collapse the entire structure. The Al-Manar, a T.V. news channel reported after six days of that incident that Jewish groups had scripted this tragedy. Otherwise how come four thousand Jewish employees working in that building remained absent on that fateful day. (News agency, Rashtariya Sahara, November 15, 2006)

The fact of the twin tower tragedy is now slowly being revealed before the world. Besides these news reports, few months ago this topic was a hot debate in the Japanese Parliament for two days. Doubts surrounding the incident have not been cleared so far.

The Incident of Gujarat

(5) Similar stories were repeated in Gujarat too. Muslims were accused of setting fire to the bogies of a train. But forensic reports revealed that fire was lit from inside and not from outside. It points to a bigger conspiracy to victimize Muslims in the name of the incident. The government of India is shying away from revealing the truth behind the train tragedy.

The Incident of Nanded

(6) The incident of Nanded falls in the same category as well. During the inquiry of bomb blasts, fake beards and other disguise items were found on the spot, so that Muslims could be held responsible for that incident. Impartial and fair investigations are not conducted to nab the actual perpetrators of bomb blasts and other crimes. Contrary to that accused are branded as culprits by various news agencies. Media never bothers to publish news of their unjustified arrest and subsequent release.

With that in view, how it is believed that those pointed out by news agencies are really involved in such incidents.

Role of Police, Administration Intelligence Agencies and Media

Respected Fellow Countrymen! Terrorism is a curse for our civilized society and a stumbling block on development. We would like to bring to your kind attention that an honest and unbiased attempt has not been made by these agencies to eradicate this menace from

our society. Governmental and non-governmental departments are equally unable to capture the real culprits. In order to throw dust in the eyes of people and keep them in dark, they point fingers at a few persons.

Police administration, intelligent agencies, print and electronic media are hand and glove with each other for defaming one particular religion. They have created an atmosphere where the accused are struggling to find lawyers for defending them for a crime which they have not committed. For instance, the bar association in U.P. has resolved not to take up cases of those who face charges of committing terrorism.

Since 2000 to 2008, India has suffered almost twenty to twenty one bomb blasts and several other horrifying and destructive incidents but it is yet to be confirmed that who is behind these incidents. Intelligence agencies and police have a list of organizations belonging to a particular religion. Their names appear in the newspapers whenever any incident takes place irrespective of whether the bombs have been detonated in a mosque, temple, tomb or a market place. In the wake of these incidents they are locked up and harassed on the pretext of interrogation. Thus, the careers and lives of these hapless adult persons are destroyed.

Police Departments and Government agencies have failed to arrest the real perpetrators of attack on parliament on July 13, 2001 five different bomb blasts in Mumbai (December 6, 2002 and January 27, May 13, August 25, 2003 and July 28, 2003), blasts at Malegaon (September 8, 2006), blasts of Mecca Masjid Hyderabad (May 18, 2007), blasts of Babri Masjid (July 28, 2005), blasts of Akshar Dham temple (September 24, 2002), blasts of Samjhauta Express train (February 8, 2007), serial bomb blasts of Uttar Pradesh (November 23, 2007) and several others. Negligence of duty and lack of impartial investigations are the main reason behind their failure. They treat the accused as a real culprits, which is against human rights. They treat them in a manner, not sanctioned by the laws. .

Role of Media

Also the role of Media is not fair under such circumstances. Media should explain the incidents and happenings of society in a positive

light. It is not their duty to give final decision like a judge and project the accused person as a culprit. This leads society towards chaos and destruction and may open the door of violence and injustice. It is also the fault of the media that they link the action of an individual with his/her religion. Such a role of media makes the situation more troublesome and fans hatred and enmity in the society.

Demand from Government

In view of that, we demand from the government to assure transparency in investigation, so that the real culprits could be caught easily. Transcending barriers of caste and creed, we do not have an iota of mercy and flexibility for culprits. We only demand that innocents should not be harassed and their careers should not be ruined. The Government should enact a law that may ably eradicate cruelty and injustice. While there are many who get freed with due honor by the court, there are also many who languish in jail for years merely because their cases have not been decided by the court. It will certainly ruin their career. The government should pay compensation for the loss.

Appeal to Media

We appeal to the media to distinguish between an accused and a real culprit. Every citizen has right to protect his/her life. It is more important to save the lives of innocents than to arrest the culprits. Therefore, we demand from the respected persons of media not to project accused as a real culprit before a judgment is pronounced in the court. They are ofcourse free to reveal the truth.

Provocation

Respected Audience! Every human being is sensitive about his/her religion. Especially Muslims are very sensitive about their religion and the Prophet. They can never condone a slight disrespect to their Prophet. The European countries and communally minded individuals have made it their mission to tarnish the image of Muslim holy men for causing provocations and unrest among Muslim masses. And if Muslims react to these insults, they are branded as terrorists. In the recent past a cartoonist in Denmark caricatured Prophet Mohammad

(pbuh). The release of film *Fitna* and an objectionable question about Mohammad (pbuh) in the question paper of Ranchi University are latest instances of provocation. These incidents reflect that that anti-terrorist drive of western countries is nothing but a big fraud. They do not intend to wipe out menace of terrorism from the world, but provide them fuel and ammunitions so that they may inflict maximum harm to humanity. All the right thinking men of the world should be aware of their sinister design so that they could save humanity from looming danger. Restoration of peace is must for the survival of humanity and without justice peace could not be established in the world.

An appeal to the Muslims

Respected audience! The above mentioned facts place onerous responsibility upon our shoulders. We have to work hard to spread the true message of Islam among general masses and strictly observe Islamic principles in our day-to-day life. At a time when Islam is under attack from every side, we have the responsibility to follow *sharia* in its totality. If we will not act according to Islamic *sharia* then we will be accused of bringing disrepute to Islam. Islam teaches honesty, truthfulness, fair dealing and good manners. These qualities should reflect in our day to day life so that general masses should understand Islam in a more practical way.

We are opposed to every kind of terrorism. We firmly believe that a true Muslim can never become a terrorist. It is our duty to follow the right path and not indulge in any activity that causes disrespect to Islam. Our right action can only counter growing tide of anti-Islamic propaganda unleashed by detractors of Islam.

An appeal to the fellow countrymen

We want to inform our fellow countrymen that menace of terrorism does not affect members of a particular community only. It is a menace that affects members of every religion and community and is a curse for a civilized society. Therefore, all of us cutting across religious and political barriers should come forward to root out this menace from our society. Protection of life and property, environment, availability of safe drinking water, medical requirements etc. are vital necessities for the survival of a society. But terrorism poses a great

hurdle to the availability of these basic provisions of life. Feudalism and terrorism have hand in glove with each other. Both have encouraged in various ways so that handful of persons should maintain their hold over resources of the world. The capitalist forces have their hand in spiraling price rise, suicide of farmers and destruction of small-scale industries etc. In order to deflect attention from these issues terrorism has been encouraged. Sense of deprivation and injustice breed terrorism. An international attempt has been made to blow menace of terrorism out of proportion, so that capitalist forces keep on maintaining their hold over resources of the world. Common men of every religion have been worst sufferers of political and capitalist exploitation. Therefore religious and sectarian angle should not be attributed to the menace of terrorism.

Both Hindus & Muslims have shown remarkable communal unity after the bomb blasts in Varanasi and Jaipur. Ours is a collective fight against terrorism. We are confident that we will win the war against terrorism.

Declaration of Stand

Lastly, I would like to declare that Islam is a religion of peace and brotherhood. It is terrorism to attribute to the religion violence and destruction. We severely condemn those elements that attempt to malign Islam and its Prophet in the name of terrorism.
